What is Helping Hands?

The **Helping Hands Outreach** purpose is to build connections among Prince of Peace members by providing assistance for aging challenges and those who are experiencing a time of special need in the following ways:

1. *Connecting members in need with transportation options for Sunday morning worship services, appointments and other essential tasks.*
2. *Connecting members in need with personal visits to deliver a bulletin, announcement packet and other items.*
3. *Connecting members in times of joy and hours of need with personal visits to deliver a meal.*
4. *Connecting members to educational opportunities focusing on community, health and spiritual needs.*

Helping Hand's Schedule & Activities

The team has group meetings 3 to 4 times a year, generally on Tuesday mornings at 10:30 am. Throughout the year, the team provides the following services:

Transportation
