- **1.** Visit the Riverview Gardens, Inc. event registration page: https://cerv.is/0274geDnBsX HINT: Registration form was blocked on my PC, but worked on iPad using Safari browser.
- 2. Click on the "Register" button at the bottom of the page.
- **3.** Follow the on screen instructions to access the CERVIS registration system. If this is your first time using the CERVIS online registration system, you will be prompted to create a Volunteer Profile.
- **4.** Once you have successfully logged into the system (or created a profile, if needed) you will automatically be registered for this event and receive a confirmation e-mail.
- **5.** If you would like to register additional individuals for this event, please select their name from the list and enter the code below into the "Private Registration Code" field. Next, click the "Register for selected event" button to complete the additional registration.

- You are welcome to participate even if you have to leave before 3:30; it is helpful to arrive at the start of the shift.
- Materials are provided; you may want to bring garden gloves and a water bottle.

Our 2024 workdays include presenting a check from the Appleton Conference ELCA congregations. In addition, a Thrivent Action Team grant has been secured to purchase supplies for Riverview Gardens.
