First Calvary Baptist Church was organized in 1884 as Second Baptist Church on Cameron Street which is now Cornell Street. A year later a wood frame building was erected with Rev. Henry Johnson as its first Pastor. Reverend W.D. Smith later became the pastor in 1926 and was responsible for acquiring the current site of the church on Morehead and Kent Streets.
