Health Sunday Topic: Breast Cancer Awareness

Early detection and treatment offer the best chance of surviving breast cancer. It is not known how to prevent breast cancer, but we do know if found early, the chance for successful treatment is greatest. When cancer cells are confined to the breast, the 5-year survival rate is over 95%.



The death rate is higher for African American women than any other race due to lack of proper screening, treatment and follow-up. Mammograms are especially important for African-American women, who have a high death rate from breast cancer. Many African American women have dense breast tissue so if they feel a lump even with a negative mammogram, they should contact their physician.

Remember the ABC's to early detection: A - Annual screening mammography for women at age 40.
 (Women between 40 and 44 have the option to start screening with a mammogram every year. Women 40 to 54 should get mammograms every year. Women 55 and older can switch to a mammogram every other year.

B - Be informed.

C - Clinical breast exam – by a trained medical professional at least every 3 years starting at age 20 and yearly after age 40

Know your risks: Women are at increased risks if they:

- Began menstruating early or had a late menopause
- Are obese (BMI greater than 30)
- Had their first child after the age of 30
- Have an excessive alcohol intake

- Have 1st degree relative (mother, sister) with breast cancer
- Have high fat diet

See your health care provider right away if you notice:

- A lump or mass in your breast or armpit
- Swelling localized in an area of your breast
- Dimpling of the skin
- Nipple pain or inversion
- Nipple discharge
- Dry, scaling areas of the skin
