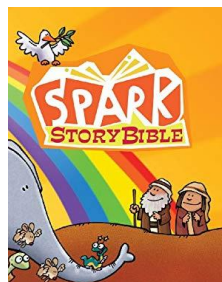


Bibles:

In our S.S. classrooms, we use the "Spark Story Bible" for Age 3-Grade 3 and the "NRSV Spark Bible" for Grades 4 - 5. (The Spark NRSV bible is also used by our Confirmation youth Grades 6 – 8). We encourage children to bring their Bibles with them to S.S. to follow along during story time. There are Bibles in each classroom that can be used by students as well. Our S.S. program is devoted to learning more about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and the Bible. Our goal is to help strengthen each child's relationship with Jesus Christ, strengthen faith, and encourage them to share their faith with others.

Who Can Attend?

We welcome children Age 3 to Grade 5 to Sunday School. We ask that your child is potty trained.

When is it?

Sunday School is one hour in length and begins at 9:30 am.

Worship service times are 8:00 & 9:30 am

What does the SS hour look like?

9:30 - 10:30 am

Children start out in their classroom and the SS Staff will bring the children in to worship for Children's Time for the first 10 minute where children will experience the children's sermon, including the S.S. Bible story of the day, and the opportunity to give the gift of their offering. Then the children will have class time with their teachers and music time with Lisa Sauer.

Curriculum:

Our staff will continue to utilize an online curriculum from Sparkhouse.

Singing in Worship:

The S.S. children sing in worship 3-4 times during the year. After the children are done singing they go to their class time.

Christmas Program:

Our SS Christmas Program will take place on Sunday, December 17, 2023 at 9:30 am for all grade levels.

There will be a full dress rehearsal practice on Saturday, December 16, 2023 at 9:30 am

Safety first:

We ask parents to bring their child(ren) to their classrooms before S.S. begins and pick them up in their classrooms when S.S. ends.

Sunday School Voluntary Fee:

There is a *voluntary* donation of \$20 per child with a family maximum of \$40. If you wish to pay this voluntary donation, enclose it with your registration form.

Sunday School Offering:

Sunday School offering envelopes will be given to each family on the first day of S.S. Children can turn in their offering when they come to worship for Children's Time or in their classroom.

Please continue to teach your children the value of regular giving.
