Friends in Christ,

All Saints Lutheran Church is approaching an important milestone in the life of the church. We will celebrate our 40th anniversary on November 4th, 2024. At the same time, we are endeavoring to do something bold and new in this place. We are in the process of calling a full-time associate pastor.



The staffing committee discovered that we, as a church, want to call a pastor of children, youth, and family ministries to our staff. However, in order to call a full-time associate pastor, our total budget would need to increase by 20% (which is only up 4% from the budget we passed in 2021). Our mock pledge card campaign, in the fall, indicated that a majority of the congregation would be willing to increase their pledge in order to meet this need.

What does God have in store for All Saints Lutheran Church in the next 40 years? How can your giving reflect the bold faith you have in this place and the ministry we share? Your pledged commitments will help us to set our May 2024-April 2025 budget and make bold steps to expand our ministry for the sake of this community.

You will receive pledge materials after worship on March 3rd and we hope that you will prayerfully consider how your giving can help us meet our goals. Please join us for an open forum between services on March 10th to discuss this commitment campaign and the steps we are taking to grow the church. We look forward, with faith and hopeful anticipation, to the next 40 years (and beyond) of mission and ministry at All Saints Lutheran Church.
