## Joshua Chapter 10:1-40

### Preview:

- a. Choices have consequences.
  - b. The Day the sun stood still.
  - c. The defeat of 5 kings.

*Joshua's decision to make an agreement with the Gibeonites had long lasting consequences. If you make an agreement with another person, and it's determined that the other person was not truthful are you required to uphold the agreement? (Explain)*

- V1. The Gibeonites agreement with Israel is widely known, and the king of Jerusalem declares war on Gibeon.
- V5. The king of Jerusalem conspires with the kings of Hebron, Jarmuth, Lachish, and Eglon to defeat the Gibeonites. Why?
- V6. The Gibeonites request Israel's help.
  - a) What obligation did Israel have to support Gibeon?
  - b) Was the agreement binding?
  - c) Are there circumstances when a believer should break an agreement?
- V7. Joshua and Israel come to the Gibeonite's rescue.
- V8. God promises Israel victory over the 5 kings. Is this God's way of endorsing the agreement between Israel and Gibeon?
- 10-11. God confuses the enemies of Israel.
- 12-14. Describe the miracle God performed and its purpose.
- V20. Joshua and Israel defeat the 5 kings.
- V25. Joshua rehearses the words God gave him before the battle began. (Josh. 1:6, 7, 9)
- V40. Joshua defeated every enemy.
