GENERAL

- Must establish and foster exemplary relationships with church staff, volunteers, and members.
- Attend all church services on a weekly basis and provide services to church-wide special events/meetings as needed.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Minister of Music.

SOUND/TRAINING

- Mix sound during our Sunday worship services, and special services/events as needed.
- Mix sound during technical rehearsals with worship and media team.
- Perform sound checks to troubleshoot any equipment or audio issues prior to worship.
- Train volunteers in operating sound equipment and effective mixing

- Live sound engineering of large venues consisting of at least 40 channels.

- Experience mixing different genres of music, most specifically gospel.

- Strong attentiveness and detail oriented.
- Leadership skills for directing a team of volunteers.
- Commitment and ability to work in and contribute to overall staff in a team-based environment.
